

Nightfall 2019 – Relaxed Performance Guide

Nightfall is an illuminated trail of light-based artworks, music and performance at Preston Park in Stockton-on-Tees. The event is outdoors and involves a walk through the parkland, a woodland path next to the river, the Victorian Street, Museum and bandstand areas.


The theme of the trail is 'By the Light of the Moon' with artworks inspired by the beauty of the moon and night sky as well as celebrating 50 years since the moon landings.


There are no pyrotechnic effects or fireworks at the event.



The trail is accompanied by an instrumental soundtrack.



